



**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

THAILAND**

This Memorandum of Agreement for international cooperation education, is entered into by and between the, Universitas Muhammadiyah Bima, Indonesia and Pattanakansuksa Mulniti School, Thailand.

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the parties believe that it is in their best interests to encourage direct contact and cooperation in the fields of education to be agreed upon and subject to the availability of funding and to the development of specific binding agreements;

WHEREAS, within the fields of activities to be mutually designated, both parties desire to discuss and explore the general forms of cooperation set forth below; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out such discussions and explorations, the parties desire to set forth a framework in which such interactions may occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties have entered into this MOA for the purpose of setting forth their understanding and agreement with respect to the potential establishment and operation of cooperative programs.

1. Both parties agree to encourage the following activities in particular to promote international academic cooperation:

ALUMNI TEACHING PROGRAM

2. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be applicable for education organizations attached to each party. Before the implementation of these activities, both parties shall discuss the related issues for the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements based on the forms of implementation upon mutually agreed benefit.
3. This Memorandum of Agreement shall become effective as of the date of signature by representatives of both parties. Any amendment or termination of the Agreement shall not be effective without mutual consent in writing between the two parties. In the event of any different interpretation between any of the texts, the English text shall prevail. Both parties agree that this Memorandum of Agreement should be reviewed every 2 (two) year, in order to evaluate progress and to improve quality of the cooperation.
4. Based on this Memorandum of Agreement, both parties recognize that financial provision for the collaborative program is limited, each party shall endeavor to provide support in the following matter:

UMB is responsible for:

- 1) Sending its alumni (maximum 4) every year to Pattanakansuksa School;
- 2) Conducting internal selection process to appoint qualified alumni;

3) Giving orientation for the candidate about the program.

Pattanakansuksa is responsible for:

- 1) Salary for the teachers 10.000 bath/month;
- 2) Return tickets for the teachers when they have completed the contract;
- 3) Health insurance for the teachers during their contract of working;
- 4) Accommodation and local transport for the teachers to and from the Host Institution;
- 5) Working visa costs for the teachers; and
- 6) Giving a semester break for the teacher to visit his/her home country.

5. Anti-Discrimination

Both parties will sign to the policy of equal opportunity and avoid any discrimination on the basis of race, age, ethnicity, religion or nation origin. Universitas Muhammadiyah Bima, Indonesia and Pattanakansuksa Foundation School, Thailand shall abide by these principles in the administration of this Agreement.

6. Nonbinding Terms

This MOA shall not be deemed to be a binding agreement and shall not be enforceable in any court or tribunal for any purpose. The settlement of possible disputes regarding interpretation and/or fulfilling of the present Agreement shall be requested to a c o m m i s s i o n of arbitration comprised by the signers of the Agreement or persons who have been delegated, and will take good faith negotiation to solve the problem arisen.

7. The parties agree that this Memorandum is binding and will act only as an interim understanding until further agreement are reached for the separate activities identified within this Memorandum.
